ORDER

As per Government Order read as 1st paper above Government have formulated a scheme to give appointment to outstanding sportsmen/women in public service. As per this scheme, 20 posts in all are set apart every year for the appointment of sportspersons.

As per the notification read as 2nd paper above, Government have invited applications from candidates having achievements in the field of sports/games for appointment in the 100 posts due for the period 1997-2001, and as per G.O read as 3rd paper above, a select list approved by the Selection Committee was published. There were 10 vacancies apportioned for the Group X in the notification dated, 23/12/2003, and as per G.O. read as 4th and 5th papers above appointments to 10 incumbents in Group X have been ordered. Shri Anil Kumar.S., Ambika Vilas, Kuppakonam Road, Nedumangad, Thiruvananthapuram who was appointed as Peon in the Director of Public Instructions as per G.O.(MS) No.293/05/GAD dated, 10/8/2005 has not jointed duty. Shri Anil Kumar has been again directed to report duty as per the Government letter read as 7th paper above within 15 days from the date of receipt of the Government letter. The DPI in his letter dated, 4.4.2007 has informed that Shri Anil Kumar has not reported for duty till then. In the above circumstances, his appointment is hereby cancelled with immediate effect.

The next person in the reserve list of the select list is Kum.Susan Rajan. She is a Shuttle Badminton player. Her qualification is SSLC, and Plus Two . She has applied for the post of LDC (1st Choice), for which she is qualified at the time of application. In her application she has stated that she is now active in sports. In her representation dated, 26.5.2007, she has requested to post her in a supernumerary post in the Revenue Department at Civil Station, Irinjalakkuda.

In the above circumstances Government are pleased to accord sanction for the appointment of Smt.Susan Rajan as Lower Division Clerk in the Revenue Department in the scale of pay of Rs.5250-8390 in the supernumerary post in the Non Joining Duty vacancy of Shri Anil Kumar.S under the scheme of Sports Quota appointment for the year 1997-01.

The candidate appointed in supernumerary posts shall be absorbed against regular posts on retirement from active sports or when she attain 35 years of age which ever is earlier. In case she wish to continue her sports activities even after 35 years of age the Heads of Departments/Appointing authority concerned should take up the matter with Government separately.

The appointments under the scheme will be subject to the provisions contained in Para (13) and (14) of Appendix to G.O. read as 1st paper above which are extracted below:

- (13) The Rules in the Kerala State and Subordinate Services Rules, 1958 and the special rules in regard to age, probation, etc., shall apply to the sports persons appointed under the scheme but the rules regarding reservation of appointments shall not apply.*
- (14) Rules regarding verification of character and antecedents shall apply in the case of candidates appointed under the scheme. The candidates allotted for appointment under the scheme shall be initially appointed temporarily under General Rules 9(a)(i) of Part II of the Kerala State & Subordinate Services Rules, 1958 and regularized later, after their character and antecedents have been verified and found to be satisfactory.*

6. The appointment will be purely provisional and subject to the final verdict of the Honourable High Court of Kerala in various O.Ps and Writ Petitions filed in this regard, challenging the notification, select list and Government Orders read above. The Head of Department/ Appointing Authority concerned will issue necessary posting order to the candidate mentioned above separately. The candidate allotted in supernumerary post will be given posting as far as possible in her place of choice, with a view to enable her to

continue the sports and games activities. The Appointing Authority shall verify the certificates/ testimonials (as in the case of Public Service Commission recruitments) before the candidate is admitted to duty. The Appointing Authority will report compliance of this Government Order and also to report non-joining duty of candidate to Government promptly.
