1. Applications are invited from sportsmen/women who have made the following achievements in sports/games disciplines shown in **Annexure I** during the calendar year 2005, for appointment in the State Government service under the *scheme of appointment of outstanding sportsmen/women in public service*.

- (i) Those who were members of the team which represented the country in the International Championships; viz. Olympics, World Cup, World University Games, Commonwealth Games, Asian Games, Afro Asian Games, Asian Championship, or SAF Games which are cleared by the Government of India and won first, second or third position in individual or team events.
- (ii) Those who have represented the country in the above International Championships.
- (iii) Those who have represented Kerala State in national senior championships for men/women or national games and won first, second or third place.
- (iv) Those who have represented Kerala State in national senior championships for men/women or national games.
- (v) Those who have represented University in the all India Inter university competitions and won first place.

*Note:*—(a) Only those sports/games items which have been included in Olympics/ Asian Games and other championships as mentioned in Annexure I will be taken into account for giving employment under the scheme.

(b) The order of priority and other guidelines for selection of candidates will be those stated in the **Annexure IV** of this notification.

## 2. Selection Procedure

2.1 The selection of the candidates for appointment will be made purely on the basis of achievements in the field of sports/games as given above.

2.2 *Number of vacancies.*—The present selection is for 20 vacancies for the year 2005 and the appointment will be done on the basis of the vacancies apportioned among various disciplines as shown in **Annexure I**.

2.3 Approved World Competition means the competition organized by the International Apex Bodies of the discipline concerned and in which the national teams are sponsored by the National Apex Bodies and cleared by the Sports Authority of India/Government of India.

2.4 The National Championship means the Championship conducted by the National Apex Body of the discipline concerned once in a year.

2.5 Individual game/event means a game/event in which an individual performs alone. Individual event is one in which the achievement is the result of the contribution by one individual as participant and team event is one in which the achievement is the result of contribution of more than one individual as participants.

2.6 When a candidate has a number of achievements in different disciplines, his/her best achievement will be considered for appointment.

2.7 The achievements made in the field of sports for the calendar year 2005 alone will be considered for appointment.

2.8 All competitions where an upper age limit is fixed would be treated as junior event provided the National Federation concerned does not classify it as a senior event.

2.9 If a candidate represents the Indian University team in the World University Championship for men/women, he/she shall be considered for the benefit of the norms only if he/she was a student in one of the Universities in Kerala during the year of representation.

2.10 When there is a tie in any of the achievements listed above, the following criteria in the priority listed will be applied to break the tie.

- (a) Individual achievements will be ranked above team achievements.
- (b) If a new record is created he/she will be given next priority.
- (c) Captaincy in the higher competition will be given the next place.
- (d) If there is still a tie, a candidate who is senior in age on the date of inviting application will be given next priority.
- (e) If a tie cannot be broken by any of the above-mentioned criteria, percentage of marks in the qualifying examinations will be the basis for breaking the tie.

2.11 The selection will be made by a Committee constituted by the Government for the purpose.

2.12 (a) The candidates so selected and recommended for employment by the Selection Committee may be appointed against the posts listed in **Annexure II** subject to their suitability with reference to their qualifications prescribed for the post as required under the Special Rules.

(b) 10% of the total number of posts notified for appointments (2 posts) will be set apart for appointments in the posts mentioned in category VI of Annexure II (Assistant Grade II). Appointment in these posts will be made as follows:—

- (i) Those selected candidates who have got the highest achievements in the field of sports/games will be considered irrespective of the discipline.
- (ii) If there is a tie, the percentage of marks the candidates have got, for the qualifying examinations prescribed for the posts of Assistant Grade II will be taken into account.

2.13 The Government may, on the recommendations of the Committee restrict the number of candidates to be selected under each discipline of Sports/Games.

2.14 The Government shall determine on the advice of the committee, whether active sports persons or those who have retired from active sports career or both should be selected during a year, the number to be selected in each category and the departments and posts in which they should be appointed.

2.15 Interview of the candidates may be conducted, if found necessary by the Committee.

2.16 **In order to avoid the complaints about the select list, a provisional rank list will be published after conducting interview of candidates. Written complaints if any, against this provisional rank list should be submitted to the Principal Secretary to Government, General Administration (Services-D) Department, Government Secretariat within 15 days of the publication of the said rank list. The final select list will be published after examining such complaints.** The selected candidates for each category of post shall be ranked in the order of merit for allotment and appointments.

### 3. Instructions to candidates and General Conditions

3.1 *Application and Identification forms.*—Candidates should apply in the format appended as Annexure III typed on white plain paper of foolscap size. The Application should be filled up in the candidate's own handwriting, dated and signed by him/her. The Identification form in Annexure III (a) should be duly filled up by the candidate, dated and signed and authenticated by the Identifying Officer who should be a Gazetted Government Officer. The candidates, who are already employed under Government of India or any State Governments or employed with any Public Sector Undertakings owned or controlled by the said Governments, should send their applications only with the No Objection Certificate in the prescribed form as shown in Annexure-III from the employer. If the No Objection Certificate is not produced along with the application, it will be summarily rejected. Those who have got employment under sports quota, in Central / State Government service or in the Public Sector Undertakings controlled by the Central/State Governments, are not eligible to apply under this scheme.

3.2 *Enclosures.*—The following enclosures should be firmly stitched along with the application form:

- (i) Copies of documents to prove educational qualifications (including mark list) and experience.
- (ii) Copies of documents in support of age and date of birth.
- (iii) Copies of documents obtained from the Sports Organisations concerned, which conducted the Championship to prove the achievements in sports mentioned in paragraph I of this notification. Certificates issued by any other Association/Organization will not be accepted.
- (iv) Two copies of the recent passport size photographs of the candidates one pasted and signed by the candidate on the application form and the other with the identification certificate (prescribed in Annexure–III) duly attested by a Gazetted Government Officer.
- (v) Copies of the certificates from the competent authority in the case of the candidates for whom relaxation of age limit is admissible.
- (vi) Identification certificate [in the prescribed format—with the application in Annexure III (a)].
- (vii) In the case of Physically Handicapped person copies of certificates to prove disability to be produced.

3.3 All the copies of the documents sent along with the application should be self-attested.

3.4 *Whom to address.*—The application complete in all respects along with its enclosures should be sent in envelopes, superscribed with the name of the post, addressed to:

3.5 The candidates may apply for any of the posts given in Annexure II, provided they satisfy the qualification prescribed for that post. A candidate, who wishes to apply for more than one post, need not send separate applications. They can apply for any post in one application stating their order of preference.

3.6 *Last date.*—The last date for receipt of the application in the office of the Principal Secretary to Government, General Administration (Services D) Department, Thiruvananthapuram is **21-3-2006** at **4.00 p.m.** Belated applications will not be considered.

### 3.7 *Invalid applications:—*

- (a) The applications having the following defects /irregularities will summarily be rejected:
- (i) Incomplete or illegible.
  - (ii) Unsigned.
  - (iii) Without the requisite number of photographs and enclosures.
  - (iv) Unattested copies of documents.
  - (v) Identification Certificate not properly authenticated.
  - (vi) Applications submitted without the *No Objection Certificate* from the employer in the case of candidates who are already employed in the service of the Government of India or any State Governments or employed with any Public Sector Undertakings of the said Governments.
  - (vii) Those who have got employment through sports quota in Central/State Governments or in the Public Sector Undertakings controlled by Central/State Governments.
- (b) The candidate should ensure that he/she fulfils the eligibility criteria and that the particulars furnished by him/her are correct in all aspects.

3.8 *Age:—*The candidate should complete 18 years of age and should not have completed 35 years as on 1st January, 2006. However, usual relaxation of the upper age limit prescribed under rule 10 (c) of General Rules of Kerala State & Subordinate Service Rules, 1958 will be available for Scheduled Caste /Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes.

## 4. **Appointment**

4.1 The selected sports persons who wish to pursue sports will be appointed against the supernumerary posts to be created to accommodate them in departments. They shall be absorbed against regular posts in the departments on completion of 35 years of age or on retirement from active sports whichever is earlier.

4.2 The selected sports persons who wish to retire from active sports or have already retired from active sports shall be straightaway appointed against regular posts.

4.3 Canvassing in any form will be a disqualification for appointment.
