**Government Guest Houses - Reservation of Accommodation in
Government Guest Houses - Procedures and other allied

ORDER

It has come to the notice of the Government that accommodation could not be provided at Government Guest Houses to VIP's/VVIP's visiting State due to continued occupation of persons other than VIP's/VVIP's. This causes unnecessary expenditure to the Government by way of providing accommodation in Hotels. In order to minimise unnecessary expenditure in this regard Government have decided to streamline the procedure to provide accommodation in Government Guest Houses. Therefore, Government consider it necessary to modify the existing orders issued in the Government Order read above. Accordingly Government are pleased to issue the following orders :

1. Allotment of rooms to M.P's/MLA's in the Guest Houses shall be limited to three days at a time.
2. No accommodation shall be provided in Guest Houses to other persons in the name of Ministers/MLA's/Officers etc.
3. The officers other than the State Government Officers viz. Officers of the Armed Forces, Public Sector Undertakings (both Central and State), All INDIA Service Officers who belongs to other State cadre and other State Government employees shall be charged half the normal rate of rent in the Guest House, Kanyakumari, Kovalam and Munnar for both official and private visits.
4. No Government officers either State Government or All India Service Officers shall be allowed to stay in the Guest House, Thycaud, Thiruvananthapuram for more than 10 days at a time. If any officer is allowed to stay in the Guest House, Thycaud for more than 10 days at a time as a special case, he/she shall be charged half the normal rent for the next ten days and full rent for the remaining days.
5. Officers, with headquarters at Thiruvananthapuram shall not ordinarily be allowed accommodation in the Guest House, Thycaud, Thiruvananthapuram. If any accommodation is provided they shall be charged the existing normal rent. But All India Service Officers who are on transfer to Thiruvananthapuram shall be allowed accommodation as per the condition in para 4 above.
6. Allotment of accommodation in the Guest House, Thycaud, Thiruvananthapuram will be made on bed basis as in the case of Kerala House, New Delhi. However sitting MLA's/MP's, Judges of High Courts, Ex-Ministers, Advocate General, Vice-Chancellors, Chairperson and Members of State Commissions, Secretaries to Government, Chairman and Members of Kerala Public Service Commission, and officers who are drawing a basic pay equal to and above the minimum of the scale of pay of Secretaries to Government of Kerala shall be provided with rooms on a non sharing basis without any additional charges.

This order shall come into force with effect from the 1st November, 2001.
