**PUBLIC SERVICES – STRIKE BY A SECTION OF GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES
ON 29TH SEPTEMBER 2005 – MODIFIED ORDERS ISSUED**

ORDER

In the G.O referred above, specific instructions were issued to deal with the threatened strike by a certain organisations of State Government Employees and Teachers on 29-9-2005. These instructions contained inter alia the specific grounds on the basis of which leave could be granted to employees. It was also ordered that the unauthorised absence of the employees for participation in the strike would be treated as dies-non.

Government have examined the matter in detail and order that eligible leave may be granted to the employees who were not able to attend the office on 29-9-2005 due to less transport facilities, by accepting their self-declaration that they had no intention and interest to participate in the strike on 29-9-2005 and that their absence from duty on that day was due to shortage of conveyance.
