

degree” the words “Preference will be given to,” the words “those who have acquired” shall be inserted;

(b) in the note 1 below the entries in column (4) against items (10) to (14) of the said category, after the words “Preference will be given to”, the words “those who have acquired” shall be inserted.

(c) In sub item 3 of item (ii) of the entries in column (4) against items (15) to (20) of the said category, before the words “M.Sc, B.Ed”, the word “OR” shall be inserted;

(d) the note below the entries in column (4) against items (21) to (27) of the said category shall be numbered as note 1 thereof and after note 1 so numbered, the following notes shall be inserted, namely:-

2. In the case of Philosophy, Psychology or Commerce in the absence of B.Ed, Degree holders, candidates having Master’s degree with not less than 50% marks and who have passed the State Eligibility Test will be considered. Preference will be given to those who have acquired Ph.D or M.Phil. Degree or qualified at the Junior Research Fellowship/National Eligibility Test. The teachers appointed under this provision shall acquire B.Ed Degree at their own expense within five years from the date of entry in service.

(e) in item (ii) of the entries in column (4) against items (37) and (38) of the said category, the words “any branch of study with” shall be omitted;

(f) in items (i) of the entries in column (4) against item (39) of the said category after the words “M.Tech in Electronics”, the words or Electronics and Communications” shall be inserted.

(3) in sub item (ii) under rule 6 of the words “or by transfer for a total period of two year” may be inserted after “if appointed on promotion” instead of the words “for a total period of one year”.

(4) rule 7 shall be numbered as sub-rule (1) thereof and after sub-rule (1) as so numbered, the following sub-rule shall be inserted, namely:-

“(2) Relaxation in upper age limit up to 42 years as on the first day of January of the year in which the application for appointment are invited shall be allowed to the qualified ministerial staff under Higher Secondary Education Department for direct recruitment to the category of Higher Secondary School Teacher (Junior)”

(5) in rule 9 after sub rule (3), the following sub-rule shall be inserted namely:-

“(4) The teachers who have completed ten years of approved teaching service at the High Schools level in the General Education Subordinate Service shall be exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test”.
