**S.R.O. No. 116/2005** - In exercise of the powers conferred by section 36 of the Kerala Education Act, 1958 (6 of 1959), the Government of Kerala hereby make the following rules to amend the Kerala Education Rules, 1959, namely:-

**RULES**

1. *Short title and commencement.* -(1) These rules may be called the Kerala Education (Amendment) Rules, 2005.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. *Amendment of the Rules.*- In the Kerala Education Rules 1959 in Chapter XXXII.

(1) Under rule 5 the note shall be "Appointments to teaching posts shall be made on the recommendation of a selection committee consisting of the Manager or his nominee (Chairman), Principal of the school and a panel of officers not below the rank of a Deputy Collector or officers not below the rank of Deputy Secretary to Government prepared by the Director Higher Secondary Education for every academic year.

(2) in the Table under rule 6,-

(a) in item (1) of the entries in column (4) against item (39) of category "2 Higher Secondary School Teacher or Higher secondary school teacher (Junior)", after the words "M.Tech. in Electronics" the words "or Electronics and Communication" shall be inserted;

(b) for the entries in column (4) against category "(5) Librarian Grade IV", the following shall be substituted namely:-

“Pass in S.S.L.C Examination and Certificate in Library Science recognized by Government”.

(3) in sub-item (ii) under rule 7 the words “or by transfer for a total period of two years” may be inserted after if appointed on promotion instead of the words “for a total period of one year”.

(4) in rule 10 after sub-rule (3) the following sub-rule shall be inserted, namely:-

“(4) The teachers who have completed ten years of approved teaching service at the High Schools level shall be exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test”.

Government have decided to amend the method of appointment and qualification of Teachers and Non-teaching staff in aided Higher Secondary Schools published vide G.O.(P).No. 331/2001/G1.Edn. dated 9-11-2001 as S.R.O. No. 1009/2001 dated 12-11-2001.
