## ORDER

1. As per Government order read as third above, among other things, it was ordered that all appointments of teachers in Government/Aided Schools upto 14.7.2001 will be approved if those are in accordance with the statutory Provisions of KERs. It was also ordered therein that in future no new appointments will be made in the schools without the prior approval of the Government. In the Government order read as fifth paper Government have further ordered that all appointments of teaches in Government/Aided schools upto 29.10.2001, made in accordance with the provisions of KERs shall also be approved.

2. In the Government order read as sixth above it was interalia ordered as follows:

-

- 1) The appointment and promotions made from among the existing teachers against new division vacancies after 29.10.2001 will be approved from the date of their appointment/promotion, to ensure their continuance.
- 2) All the appointments of teaching and non-teaching staff made after 29.10.2001 against retirement, death and resignation vacancies will be approved with effect from the date of appointment, if those appointments were made in accordance with the provisions of the Kerala Education Rules. Their salary upto 31.5.2003 will be credited to respective P.F. Accounts and they will be paid salary in cash from June 2003 onwards. Hereafter, no new vacancies consequent on staff fixation from the academic year 2003-04 onwards shall be filled up without the prior approval of Government.

3. As per Government letter read as 7<sup>th</sup> it was clarified that the appointments made after 29.10.2001 by promotion from existing teachers and appointments made against the resultant vacancies can be approved. It was also clarified that the appointments made against transfer vacancies occurred on account of retirement, resignation and death after 29.10.2001 can also be approved. Government have not issued any orders for the approval of appointment of teachers and non-teaching staff made against leave vacancies and additional vacancies after 29.10.2001.

4. Government are receiving representations from various quarters requesting to approve the appointments of teachers in leave vacancies and additional vacancies so as to draw their salary for the period for which they have actually worked.

5. Government after having examined the matter in detail are pleased to issue the following orders.

- 1) All appointments of Aided School teachers made against regular additional division vacancies after 29.10.2001 will be approved, if otherwise eligible as per the provisions of the KER. Salary for the newly appointed teachers (except the existing teachers) upto 31.12.2003 will be credited to the PF Accounts and salary from 1.1.2004 only will be paid in cash.
- 2) All appointments of Non teaching staff made in Aided Schools after 29.10.2001 will also be approved, if otherwise eligible as per the provisions of the KER.
- 3) All the appointments made against leave vacancies after 29.10.2001 in Aided Schools will be approved, if otherwise eligible as per the provisions of the KER.

6. Hereafter the claim for re-appointment under rule 51 A of the KER will be limited to those who have been appointed against regular/leave vacancies having a duration of not less than one academic year. The vacancies having duration of less than one academic year will be filled up on daily wage basis.

7. In order to give effect to Para 6 above, necessary amendments will be made forthwith to Rule 7(3) Chapter XIV A and Rule 51 A Chapter XIV A KER for which the Director of Public Instruction will forward proposals to Government urgently.

8. The Educational Officers are hereby authorised to revise the staff fixation in accordance with the KER.
