G O (P) No. 3435/E1/1996/LBR. *Dated, Thiruvananthapuram, 10<sup>th</sup> December, 2003.*

The following proposal regarding the Minimum rate of wages payable to classes of the employees in the state employed in Umbrella manufacturing as specified in the schedule below which the Government of Kerala propose to make in exercise of powers conferred by clause (b) of sub-section (i) of section 3 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Central Act 11 of 1948) read with clause (b) of sub-section (i) of section 5 thereof and in super session of Notification issued under G O (Rt). No 878/81/LBR dated 15<sup>th</sup> July, 1981, and published as S R O No. 859/81 in the Kerala gazette Extraordinary No 566 dated 17<sup>th</sup> July 1981 are hereby published for the information of all persons likely to be affected thereby, as required by clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 5 of the said Act.

Notice is hereby given that the proposal will be taken up for consideration on or after two months from the date of publication of his notification and that objections and suggestions, if any, that may be received from any persons with respect to the said proposals on or before the date specified above, shall be considered by the Government. All objections and suggestion shall be addressed to the secretary to Government, Labour and rehabilitation (E) department, Government secretariat, Thiruvananthapuram-695 001.

### **Dearness Allowance**

In addition to the basic wages specified above Dearness Allowance shall be paid to the above categories of employees at the rate of Rs. 3.50 daily for the increase of every one point above 100 points of the consumer Prize Index Numbers published by the directorate of Economics and Statistics.

For Wayanad and Idukki districts Dearness Allowances shall be paid on the basis of Consumer Prize Index Numbers published for Meppadi Centre and Munnar Centre respectively,

In the case of employees of any establishment who are now getting higher wages than the minimum Wages fixed as per this notification, they shall continue to enjoy such higher rates.
