NOTIFICATION

G.O (MS) No.48/2005/LBR

SRO No. /05-WHERE AS, the Government of Kerala are of opinion that minimum rate of wages should be fixed under the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Central Act 11 of 1948) in respect of the following employment in the state, namely: -

“Employment in Domestic Works”.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 27 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Central Act 11 of 1948) the Government of Kerala, after having given notice of their intention to do so, as required by the said section by the issue of Notification No.15485/E1/2004/LBR dated 14th October 2004 published in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No.2264 dated 25th October 2004, hereby add the following employment to Part I of the Schedule to the said Act, in its application to the State of Kerala and consequently make the following amendment to Part I of the said schedule, namely:-

AMENDMENT

In part I of the schedule to the Minimum Wages Act, 1948, after the entry “Employment in Star Hotels”, the following entry shall be added, namely: -

“Employment in Domestic Works”

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The Government have decided to include the “Employment in Domestic Works” in Part I of the Schedule to the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 for the purpose of fixing the minimum rate of wages payable to the employees employed in the said employment.

This notification is intended to achieve the above object.
