### ORDER

The Parliamentary Affairs Department was set up vide the Government Order read above with a view to Co-ordinate the Legislative Business of the Government and to develop healthy Parliamentary practices in the State. In order to achieve the above objectives the Department proposes to implement the following Schemes/Programmes in association with the Public Relations Department C-DIT and other departments and agencies.

1) **Institute of Parliamentary Studies.**

This Institute will serve as the focal point for research, study, training and allied activities centered around areas of importance in constitutional and Parliamentary Affairs.

2) **Youth Parliament**

Youth Parliament will be developed as a movement to express children and youth to Parliamentary practices by holding regular sessions at the circle, district and State levels.

3) **The Eternal Assembly**

This will be a Hall of Fame to perpetuate the memory of the parliamentarians and others who have contributed substantially to the growth and development of Parliamentary democracy. This could be designed as a portrait gallery or a museum of statues or holographic museum.

4) **Exchange Programmes**

National and International exchange programmes will be organized for parliamentarians, youth, opinion makers and others.

**5) Curriculum**

Lessons which would foster awareness of and respect for parliamentary democracy will be included in the curriculum.

**6) Academic Backup**

Universities will be encouraged in developing academic programmes around topics relating to parliamentary Affairs. Chairs may also be instituted in memory of stalwart parliamentarians.

**7) Reforms in Parliamentary Practices**

Reforms in Parliamentary Practices will be initiated through public debate, discussions and expert studies.

**8) Documentation and publication of Parliamentary Highlights.**

Landmark legislations, important debates and contributions of veteran parliamentarians will be documented in print and electronic media.

**9) Think Tank on Parliamentary Affairs**

Think Tanks of Deliberation Councils consisting of Parliamentarians, party leaders, experts, opinion makers and academics will be setup to enlist enlightened views on important matters of state before enacting legislation and taking policy decisions.

**10) Parliamentary Gateway**

Effective networks will be established with legislature of other states and countries, academic and research institutions, international think tanks and institutions and individuals who are major stakeholders in the field.

**11) Interactive Sessions with Legislators**

Interactive Sessions with Legislators to develop good relationship with all members will be organised.

Financial Resources for the above Schemes/programmes will be raised from Budgetary support, Project funds, other departments concerned from their budget allocation, external funding agencies and sponsorship from others.
