S.R.O.No.1055/2002- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (6) of section 8A of the payment of Salaries and Allowances Act, 1951 (XIV of 1951), the Government of Kerala hereby make the following rules, further to amend the Members of the Kerala Legislative Assembly (Providing the assistance of officers) Rules 1992, issued under Notification G.O (Ms) No.27/92/GAD dated 15th January, 1992 and published as S.R.O No.35/92 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No.43, dated 15th January 1992.

Rules

1. Short title and commencement –(1) There rules may be called the Members of the Kerala Legislative Assembly (Providing the assistance of officers) Amendment Rules, 2002.
(2) Clause (a) of rule 2 shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of November, 1998 and clause (b) thereof, shall be deemed to have come into force on the 3rd day of August, 2000.
2. Amendment of the Rules-In the Members of the Kerala Legislative Assembly (Providing the Assistance of Officers) Rules. 1992, in rule 8-
(a) for sub-rule (2) the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:-

“(2) An Officer appointed under these rules shall be entitled to such special allowance, as may be sanctioned by the Government from time to time, but he shall not be eligible for any special pay or traveling allowance or daily allowance during their term of office under these rules:-

Provided that the traveling allowance for joining duty to assist the member from the place at which, the officer was working at the time of his appointment under these rules to the place where his headquarters is situated and the traveling allowance to join duty after the termination of his term of office, admissible under the relevant rules governing his service shall be borne by the office or institution in which he had been working prior to his appointment under these rules”.

- (b) after sub-rules (2) the following sub-rule shall be inserted, namely:-

“(3) An Officer appointed under these rules shall also be eligible for overtime allowance for the duty in connection with the sessions of the Kerala Legislative Assembly at such rates, as are applicable to the Officers of the Legislature Secretariat.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

As per G.O (Ms) No.1616/99(30) Fin. dated 22nd July, 1999 Government have sanctioned Special Allowance to the Personal Assistants of the Members of the Kerala Legislative Assembly with effect from 1-11-1998. As per G.O (Ms) No.458/2000/GAD dated 3rd August, 2000 Government have also sanctioned overtime allowance to them during the session of the Kerala Legislative Assembly. Consequential amendments are to be made in the Members of the Kerala Legislative Assembly (Providing the Assistance of Officers) Rules, 1992.

This notification is intended to achieve the above object.

S.R.O No.1054/2002- In exercise of the power conferred by section 10 read with sub-sections (1) and (2) of section 9A of the payment of Salaries and Allowances Act, 1951 (XIV of 1951), the Government of Kerala hereby make the following rules further to amend the Kerala Legislative Assembly Members (Free Transit by Railway) Rules, 1978 issued under G.O (Ms) No.442/78/GAD dated 28th September, 1978 and published as SRO No.964/78 in Part-1 of the Kerala Gazette No.42 dated the 17th October, 1978, namely:-

Rules

1. Short title and commencement-(1) These rules may be called the Kerala Legislative Assembly Members (Free Transit by Railway) Amendment Rules, 2002.

(2) They shall be deemed to have come into force on the 22nd April, 1994.

3. Amendment of the Rules:- In the Kerala Legislative Assembly Rules 1978, in Rule 3, for the words “Thirty five thousand Rupees” the words, “Thirty five thousand Rupees or to such enhanced amount as may be fixed by Government from time to time”, under the provision to section 9A of the Act shall be substituted.
