S. R. O. 590/2005 – In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to clause (a) of section 172 of the Electricity Act, (Central Act 36 of 2003) and as mutually decided by the Government of India and the Government of Kerala, the Government of Kerala hereby authorize the Kerala State Electricity Board to continue to function as the State Transmission Utility and a licensee for a further period of six months on and from the 10th June, 2005.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

As per Notification issued under G. O. (P) No. 13/2004/PD. Dated 10 – 6 – 2004 and published as S. R. O. No. 592/2004 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 1220 dated 10 – 6 – 2004 Government, as mutually decided by Government of India and Government of Kerala have authorized the Kerala State Electricity Board to continue to function as State Transmission Utility and a licensee for a further period of one year from 10 – 6 – 2004. The above period expires on 9 – 6 – 2005. The Government of Kerala have requested Government of India to allow Kerala State Electricity Board to continue as a Transmission Utility and a licensee beyond 9 – 6 – 2005. The Government of India as per letter No. 25/13/2004 – R & R dated 9 – 6 – 2005 allowed for the continuation of the Kerala State Electricity Board for a further period of six months beyond 9 – 6 – 2005, i.e. Up to 9–12–2005. Now the Government of Kerala decided to authorize the Kerala State Electricity Board as a State Transmission Utility and a licensee for a further period of six months from 10 – 6 – 2005.

Hence the Notification.
