S.R.O No. 938/2004.- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 3 of the Kerala Tolls Act, 1976 (6 of 1977) the Government of Kerala hereby declare that toll shall be levied beginning with the 1st day of September, 2004 on every motor vehicle, other than those belonging to the Government of Kerala or the Government of India and any stage carriage operated by the Kerala State Road Transport Corporation, entering the Madurapuram - Mallussery bridge in Chengamanad - Elavoor road in Aluva Taluk of Ernakulam District at the rates specified under the heading "Toll for bridges costing more than Rs. 100 lakhs" in Column (5) of the Schedule to the Kerala Tolls Levy Rules, 1983, for such period as may be necessary for the recovery of the amount expended upon the said bridge by the Government together with simple interest at the rate of 9% (nine percent) per annum as specified in sub-rule (3) of rule 3 of the said Rules.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the Notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The Madurapuram-Mallussery bridge in Chengamanad-Elavoor road in Aluva talk of Ernakulam District has been declared open for vehicular traffic with effect from 2-11-2001. Tolls has to be levied on motor vehicles entering the said bridge under the provision of Kerala Tolls Act, 1976. It is, therefore, necessary to issue a notification declaring the rates of toll to be levied on motor vehicles, entering the said bridge under sub-section (2) of section 3 of the said Act.

The Notification is intended to achieve the above object.
