Sir,

Sub:- Kerala Public Service Commission (Additional Functions as Respects Certain Corporations and Companies) Act, 1970 – Recruitment of Staff – Consultation with the P.S.C. – Further instructions – Issued.

Ref:- Government letters No. 93950/SD5/70/PD dated 5th June 1971 and 26th July 1971.

With the enactment of the Kerala Public Service Commission (Additional Functions as Respects Certain Corporations and Companies) Act, 1970 and the issuance of the Rules there under, Government took a policy decision that all employees of the individual Corporations and Companies excluding “Worker” as defined in the Factories Act and excluding persons employed in “supervisory” or “managerial” capacity whose basic starting salary (i.e. excluding D.A., incentive bonus etc.) exceeds Rs. 500 are to be recruited by the Public Service Commission. In the letters cited the above decision was communicated to the Chief Executives of all Government Companies and corporation to be placed before the Board of Directors of the respective concerns for taking a clear decision on the point.

2. Consequent on the upward revision of pay scales effected from 1st July 1973 or thereafter the revised pay corresponding to Rs.500 of the pre-revision pay is around Rs.700. Government have therefore decided that the existing limit of the basic pay of the posts in the Corporations and companies to which recruitment is to be made through the Kerala Public Service Commission should also be enhanced from Rs.500 to Rs.700 per mensem. Accordingly, point (1) in para 1 of the Government letter No.93950/SD5/70/PD dated 5th June 1971 as modified in the letter of the same Number dated 26th July 1971, will be substituted with the following:

(1) That all employees of the individual Corporations and Companies, excluding ‘worker’ as defined in the Factories Act and excluding persons employed in Supervisory or managerial capacity, whose basic starting salary (excluding Dearness Allowance, incentive bonus, annual bonus etc.) exceeds Rs.700 are to be recruited by the P.S.C”

3. I am to request you to place the matter before the Board of Directors of your concern for taking a clear decision on the above point and to intimate the result to Government in due course.
