ORDER

I invite your attention to the reference cited (copies enclosed). The SC/ST Welfare Committee (1989-91) has observed in its 18th report that the principles of reservation and rotation are not strictly followed in the Companies/Corporations in the matter of recruitment, I therefore request you to ensure that the instructions already issued in the matter (Vide letter dated 27-11-1980) are strictly followed.

The Committee also observed that the Public Sector Undertakings are not maintaining the two registers enabling assessment of the progress in special recruitment of SCs/STs in Public Sector Undertakings as already directed in Circular No.12507/82/BPE/Plg. Dated 3rd January 1983. I request you to ensure that the above mentioned registers are maintained in the Companies/Corporations without fail.

The Committee has also pointed out in the report that even though there are instructions that to submit quarterly review report to the concerned Administrative Department and the BPE not later than the 10th of the month, Succeeding each quarter, most of the Public Sector Undertakings do not observe these instructions. All Public Sector Undertakings are therefore directed to ensure strict compliance with instructions. Chief Executives will be held responsible for any lapse in the matter.
