Sub:- Kerala Public Service Commission(Additional Functions As Respects
Certain Corporation and Companies) Act. 1970- Consultation with
the Public Service Commission for recruitment of staff.

Ref:- Government letter No. 24141/SD4/70/PD
dated 14th August 1970.

I am directed to forward herewith a copy of the Notification S.R.O. No. 145/71 containing the Rules issued under section 4 of the Kerala Public Service Commission (Additional Functions as Respects Certain Corporations And Companies) Act, 1970(19 of 1970). The Board of Directors is requested to take a clear decision on the following points also in addition to the points raised in the Government letter cited.

- (1) That all employees of the individual corporations and companies excluding “workman “ as defined in the Factories Act and excluding “Managerial” and “supervisory: personnel under the Industrial Disputes Act are to be recruited by the Public Service Commission.
 - (2) That temporary filling up of vacancies should be discouraged and wherever necessary such recruitment is to be restricted to candidates nominated by the Employment Exchange as per rules’
 - (3) That those categories excluded by item (1) above are to be recruited by ‘Committees’ set up by the Board of Directors with not less than three members, and would be subject tot the principles of communal rotation as laid down in rules 14to 17 of the kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules Part Ii as far as is practicable;
 - (4) That in such cases, wherever Backward Communities including Scheduled Castes and Scheduled tribes are not sufficiently represented, as much weightage as possible is to be given while filling up vacancies arising in the near future.
2. I am to request you to draw up a revised list of posts and have the question of recruitment to each category of the posts examined by the Board of Directors. Government may also be informed of the decisions of the Board of Directors in the matter.
