Page No 2	"Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub-consultancy to enhance their qualifications"	At an EOI stage, is it mandatory to form the consortium and communicate the details of the consortium partners while submitting the expression of interest? It is requested that formation of the consortium be allowed after the detailed terms of reference (ToR) and request for Proposal (RfP) is issued. This would allow the applicants to compose a team that can best suit the requirements mentioned in the ToR and carry out the project more effectively. Our request may kindly be accepted.	It is mandatory to form consortium at the EOI stage as the shortlisting is based on the quality of the consortium formed.

Page No 2	"A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method set out in the Consultant Guidelines"	Request to make the consultant's guidelines available for understanding the evaluation pattern at the EoI stage itself.	Will be done only at RFP stage.
